After a brief hiatus due to the pandemic, we are happy to announce the **3rd Annual SEEDS Conference which will be held at Georgia Institute of Technology on April 27-28, 2023**. The conference will bring together social scientists from a variety of fields, including economics, international affairs, political science, public policy, and sociology.

The conference will begin at noon on April 27 and end after lunch on April 28. We expect participants to attend both days of the conference. The host institution will provide lunch on both days and reimbursement for parking. There will also be a dinner on Thursday, April 27. Preference for this funding will be given to junior scholars and to those who do not have alternative sources of support.

The conference seeks papers based on the theme of the **UN Sustainable Development Goals**. Papers on topics related to poverty, inequality, armed conflict, immigration, refugees and displacement, gender equality, public service provision, distributive politics, and social policy are encouraged but papers concerning other aspects of development studies are also welcome.
